Dr. Ronstadt is the J. Marion West Chair for Constructive Capitalism at the University of Texas at Austin, and the Director of the IC² Institute, a non-traditional think tank, whose IC² Fellows (approximately 230 world-wide), are devoted to technology commercialization, entrepreneurship, and innovative education. IC² also runs the Austin Technology Incubator and offers an in-house Masters Program in Technology Commercialization that is distance-taught both synchronously and asynchronously from IC²'s Global Classroom. Currently, IC² is working in over a dozen regions in the United States and abroad on various projects associated with technopolis development.

Dr. Ronstadt has pursued a related entrepreneurial career on part time and full time basis. The latter includes serving as CEO of Lord Publishing, a producer of business books and software, from 1985 to 1992. He is the author of the software, Ronstadt's Financials, along with numerous books including Entrepreneurial Finance, Entrepreneurship: Text, Cases, & Notes, and R&D Abroad: The Foreign Research & Development Investments of U.S. Multinationals. He is a graduate of the University of California at Berkeley (A.B. in History); the University of Oregon at Eugene; and the Harvard Business School where he earned his doctorate in International Business in 1975.
