This distinction was based on the company's staying power, growth and increased sales as well as its response to adversity, innovativeness of service and contribution to the community. Ms. Rosellini also received the Blue Chip Entrepreneurial Award, a national tribute recognizing achievement in the face of adversity. She has established herself in a male dominated industry skeptical of a woman's ability. Ms. Rosellini has also received the Avon Entrepreneurial Award, the Humanitarian Award given to her for her work with abused children through the Ed Block Courage House, Ernst & Young Entrepreneur of the Year, Top 25 Women Owned Businesses, Baltimore Business Journal, Top 100 Women in Maryland, three times; Women of Excellence Circle, which there are only 30 women to have received this honor; citations from the Baltimore Police Department for Service to the Police Officers and their family; Mayor's citation for civic welfare and commitment to community; Congressional Certificate of Merit '94 & '95; Governor's recognition for outstanding contribution to further women in business and leadership; 1995 White House certificate for outstanding commitment to conference on small business; Baltimore County certificate of recognition to the business women's community activist and loyal support to women; Japanese Business Journal awarded her International Business Person of the Year in the Japanese Magazine, "Beijing."

Ms. Rosellini holds membership in the League of Women Voters and is a Commissioner on the Baltimore County Liquor Board; Baltimore County Human Relations Commission under Baltimore County Executive, Dutch Ruppersberger. She has also served on the Baltimore City's Women's Commission for Baltimore Mayor Schموke.

Ms. Rosellini is active in many political, trade and business associations both locally and nationally. Her political involvement includes service to a Congressional appointment as the Maryland delegate for the 1995 National White House Conference on Small Business and participation on Congressman Ehrlich's Finance and Small Business Advisory Committee, as she did for his predecessor, Congresswomen Helen Bentley. Ms. Rosellini was a guest at the State of the Union Address, as well as dinner guest of both former Vice President Dan Quayle and Senator Bob Dole. Ms Rosellini has also enjoyed the company of President Clinton and Vice President Gore at a Private Dinner in Washington.
