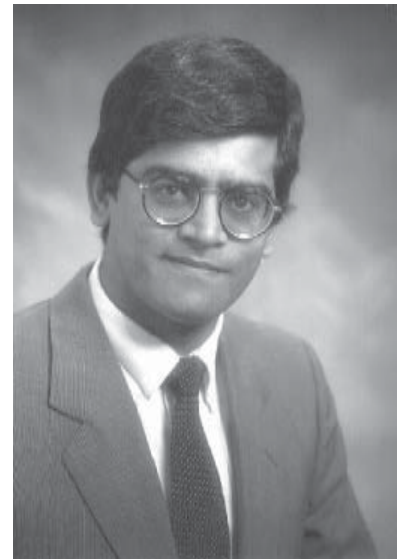


RAHIM SABADIA



Rahim Sabadia founded Sabtech Industries in 1984 as a firm specializing in developing and manufacturing computer interface products for military applications. Watching the PC revolutionizing every aspect of the work environment during the early 1980s, he wanted to develop a product for this rapidly growing market. A niche was found in 1983 and by 1984 Sabtech industries had introduced a simple interface board for the PC, to emulate the functions of multimillion dollar Navy combat systems.

At about the same time, engineers at a major defense contractor were trying to beat the clock on a project deadline to develop a display console for use in a US Navy cruiser. The company was trying hard to locate a mission computer, similar to the one used in the combat system of the Navy's cruiser. The Sabtech Naval Tactical Data Systems interface board was successfully used in a PC to emulate the functions of the mission computer and project was completed on schedule.



Since then, Sabtech has been supporting the US and Allied Navies directly and through the world's largest military contractors, with a family of computer interface products, test equipment, software and services.

Rahim's initial start in the entrepreneurial world was with his brother who taught him the ins and outs of global trading in commodities. This is where he learned how to understand and meet the needs of a customer. He was born in South Africa and immigrated to the United States in 1974. Prior to starting Sabtech, he was involved in the textile business, and subsequently cofounded a mail order business which sold kits to build electronic projects.
